- 300,000 documents found during the 1880s – 1890s
  - two-thirds (c. 200,000 documents) are in Cambridge
  - other large collections in Oxford, New York, Manchester, Philadelphia, St. Petersburg, + c. 70 other libraries, museums, and private holdings
