

**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR
JEWISH STUDIES DEPARTMENTAL AWARDS**

SPRING 2020

DEADLINE: MARCH 20, 2020

Jewish Studies Departmental Awards recognize achievements by Rutgers students in the field of Jewish Studies. To be eligible for an award, students must be sophomores, juniors, or seniors with a declared major or minor in Jewish Studies. Graduate students at Rutgers enrolled in MA or PhD programs who are doing research on a topic in Jewish Studies are also eligible for consideration. Preference is given to students who have a sustained record of achievement in Jewish Studies. Prior recipients may reapply.

To be considered for awards based on both merit and financial need, students must have a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file with the Rutgers Financial Aid Office. *NOTE: If you receive needs-based financial aid, please be advised that receiving a Jewish Studies Student Award may result in the reduction of federal student aid or loans.*

To be considered for an award, applicants must submit the following:

1. Application documents (see below)
2. An unofficial Rutgers transcript
3. Two letters of recommendation from faculty, at least one of whom must be in the Department of Jewish Studies at Rutgers. Please request these letters at least two weeks before the deadline and ask professors to e-mail their letters directly to the Jewish Studies Department Administrator, Jenny Gehrmann (jennyg13@rutgers.edu)
