#### Academic Year 2023 - 2024

**Study in Israel/Study Abroad Awards** provide financial support to full-time Rutgers students (both undergraduate and graduate) to study at any of the six accredited Israeli universities: Hebrew University, Tel-Aviv University, Bar-Ilan University, Ben-Gurion University, University of Haifa, and the Technion, or to take a class/classes related to Jewish Studies at accredited universities in other countries. Awards will only fund programs that are open to all students. Proof of acceptance to the program is required at time of application. Applicants need not be Jewish Studies majors or minors. Students must comply with all current Rutgers University policies concerning study abroad.

To be considered for an award, applicants must submit the following to the Department of Jewish Studies Administrator, Amanda Gravenhise (amanda.gravenhise@rutgers.edu). Kindly place the words "Study in Israel/Study Abroad Awards" in the subject line.

- completed application (see the following three pages)
- Rutgers transcript (an unofficial copy is fine)
- documentation of acceptance from an accredited university, if available at the time of application
- two (2) letters of recommendation from faculty members, at least one of whom must be associated with Rutgers.
